PlaySpace sessions are free 2 hour play sessions for children and young people of all ages and abilities. Children will be offered free snacks and drinks and at some venues a meal will be provided by local Community Councils. If your child has any allergies please make sure you have told us on your registration form.

The Play Scheme is run by our team of experienced and qualified Play Workers supported by volunteers. Everyone has an enhanced DBS check and has completed appropriate safeguarding and inclusion training.

Children under 8 years old must be accompanied by a responsible adult and activities will be provided for parents to play with their babies and toddlers.

Children over the age of 8 can attend alone and activities will be provided for young people up to 16. Parents are very welcome to stay and join in the activities with their older children if they want to!
